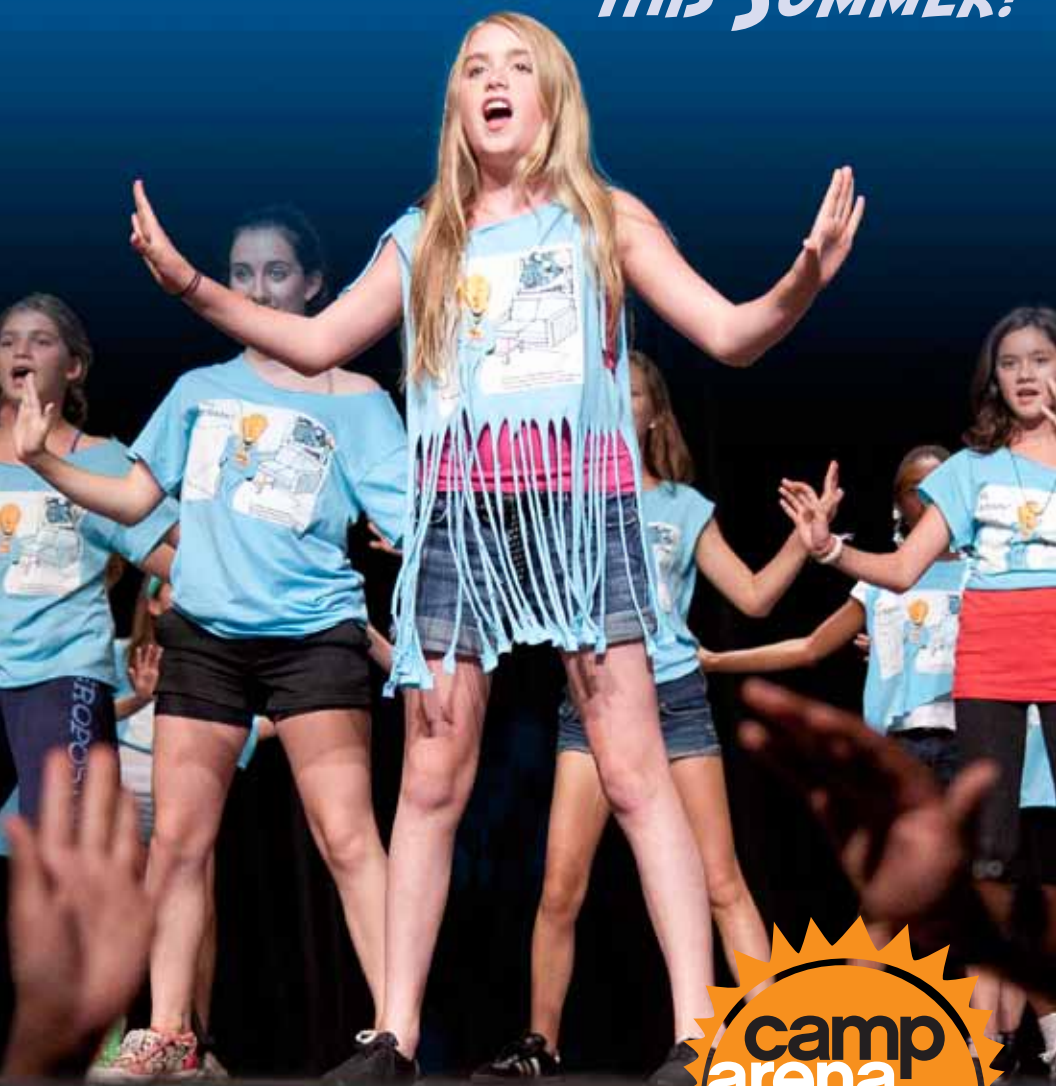

**REGISTRATION:** A nonrefundable  
deposit of \$300 is due at  
registration. The balance is due  
by June 1, 2012. After June 2,

delayed attendance.

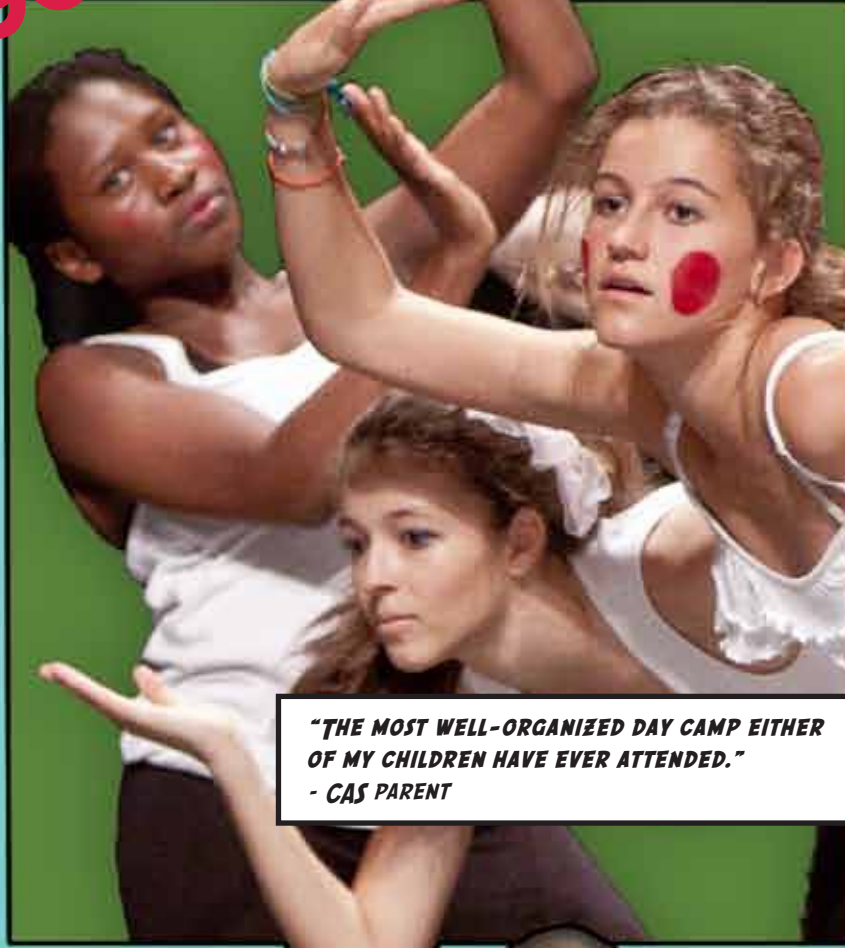
